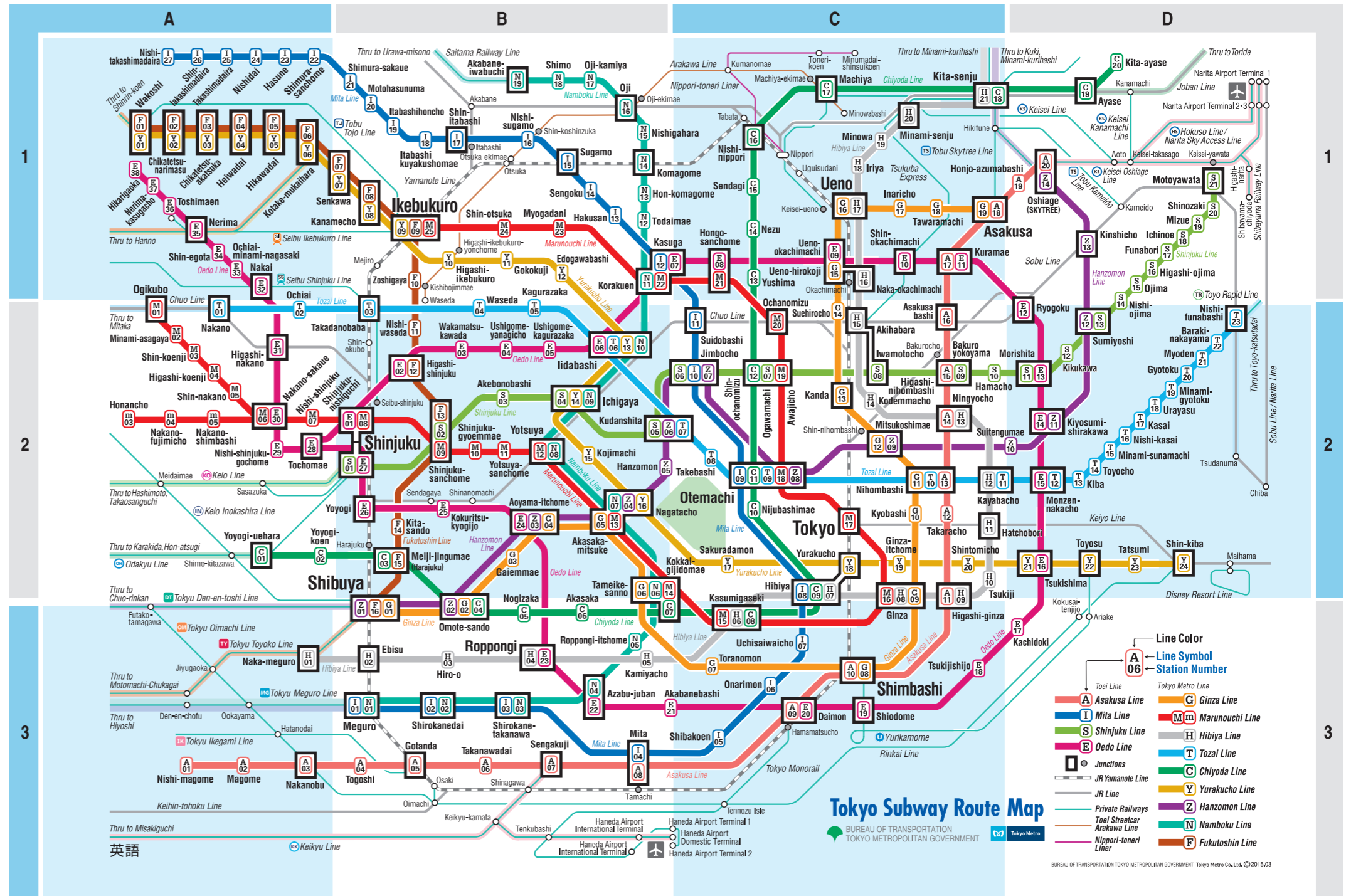

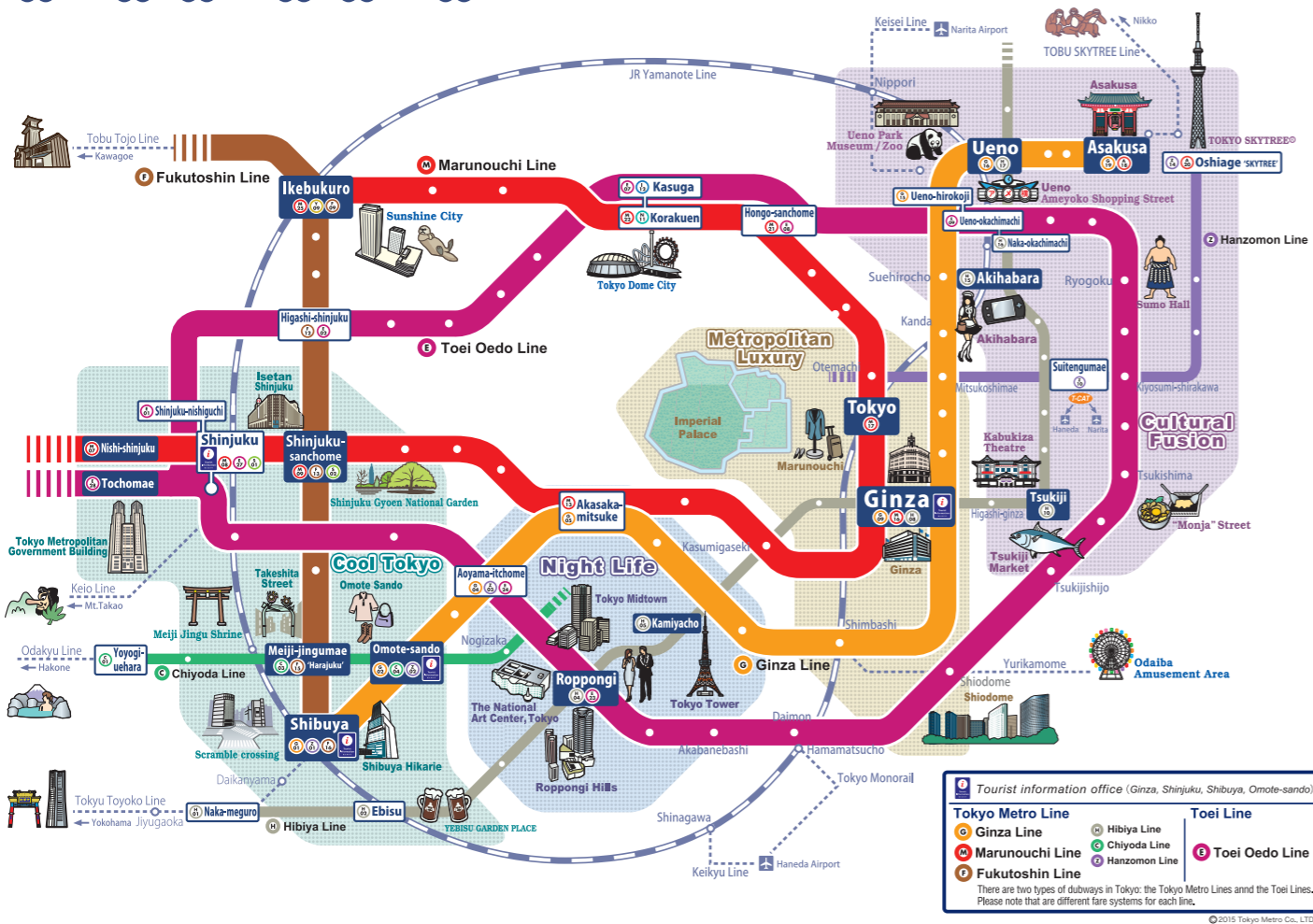

PASMO

バスモとは
 PASMO is a convenient reloadable, prepaid transportation IC card that allows its users to ride Tokyo Metro subways and most trains and buses within Japan.

Where to Purchase and Recharge the Card カードの購入・チャージ場所
 Can be purchased at Tokyo Metro IC card-compatible ticket vending machines, Tokyo Metro station offices, and at Tokyo Metro Pass Offices.
 Press the [English] button at the top right of the screen and then click [PASMO] and follow the instructions on-screen.

How to Use the Card カードの使い方
 Just touch the IC card reader on the ticket gate with your PASMO card. One advantage of using PASMO is that it lets you easily pay fares without having to calculate costs each time you want to go somewhere.
 You can also use the money you loaded on your PASMO card to purchase items at stores and vending machines marked with the PASMO/SUICA logos.

Valid Period 有効期限
 There is no expiration date for the PASMO card (it will be invalid if not used for more than 10 years from the date of last usage).
Valid Transit Lines 利用可能な交通機関
 You can use PASMO to ride not only Tokyo Metro subways but also most trains and buses throughout Japan.

If the PASMO Card Is No Longer Needed PASMOが不要になった場合
 Any remaining balance for stored fares (SF) and ¥500 deposit are returned to the user.
 Amount of money returned to the user = SF (remaining balance) + ¥500 deposit*2
 *1 The stored fare (SF) is the amount of money left on the PASMO card (remaining balance of money placed on the card).
 *2 The ¥500 deposit is an amount paid separately at the time of purchase that cannot be used as stored fare for paying transportation fees or for shopping.

Fares
 The fares for the Tokyo Metro lines vary depending on the type of ticket you use.
 Regular Tokyo Metro tickets are available in amounts of ¥170, ¥200, ¥240, ¥280, and ¥310, increasing with the distance of travel.
 For prepaid transportation IC cards such as the PASMO card, a fee of ¥165, ¥195, ¥237, ¥278, or ¥308 is charged, increasing with the distance of travel.

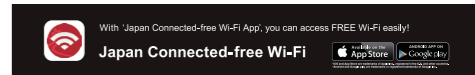

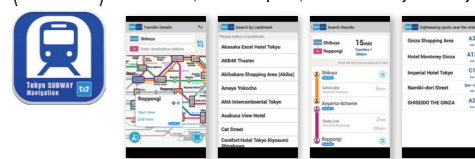

Koishikawa Korakuen
 小石川後樂園
 "Koishikawa Korakuen Gardens" is modeled after the beautiful scenery from places in Japan and China including Kyoto, Lake Biwa, and Lake Sa. The appearance of the garden—the weeping cherry blossom trees that are approximately 90 years old, the shrine hill and stone bridges—changes with the seasons and is certainly worth seeing.

Recommended Sightseeing Plan

9:30 Asakusa
 浅草
 A busy sightseeing area bustling with many people, centering around Sensoji Temple, visited by approximately 30 million people annually, and Nakamise Dori, the oldest shopping street in the Tokyo metropolitan area. A wide array of events and festivals are held throughout the year.

11:30 Tsukiji Market
 築地市場
 The world's largest fish market that handles seafood, vegetables, and fruits, among other things. Within the market grounds, there's an area called "Togashi Yokochi," where you'll find restaurants highly acclaimed by professional buyers and open to the public. If you want to shop, we recommend visiting the Joppe (outer market) area that's lively and full of people, just like a shopping district. If you're lucky, you might even be able to catch a tuna cutting show.

15:00 Tokyo Metropolitan Main Building No.1
 東京都庁 第一本庁舎
 With an overwhelming scale, the administrative central facility of the Tokyo metropolitan government is one of the largest in Japan. On the 45th floor, in addition to the observation view, you can get a full view of the city of Tokyo for free.
