PASMO is a convenient reloadable, prepaid transportation IC card that allows its users to ride Tokyo Metro subways and most trains and buses



Can be purchased at Tokyo Metro IC card-compatible ticket vending machines, Tokyo Metro station offices, and at Tokyo Metro Pass Offices.


